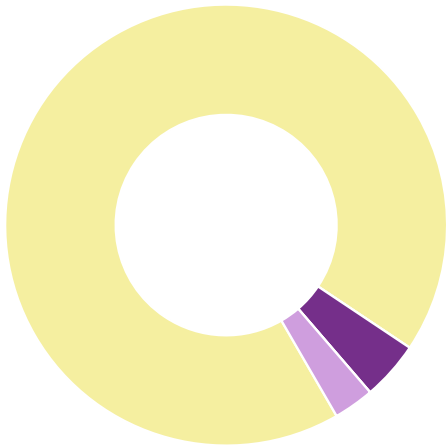

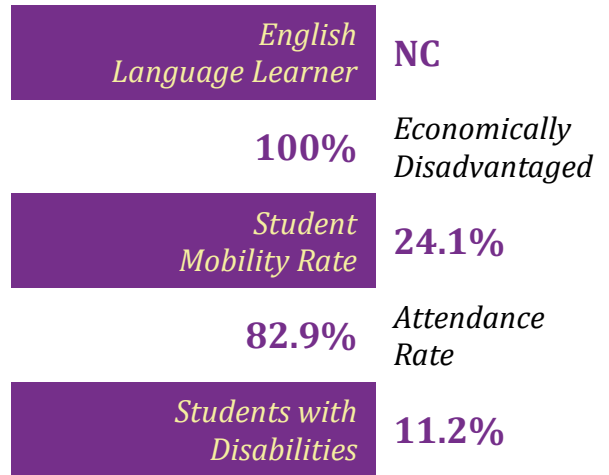

Progress towards Goals

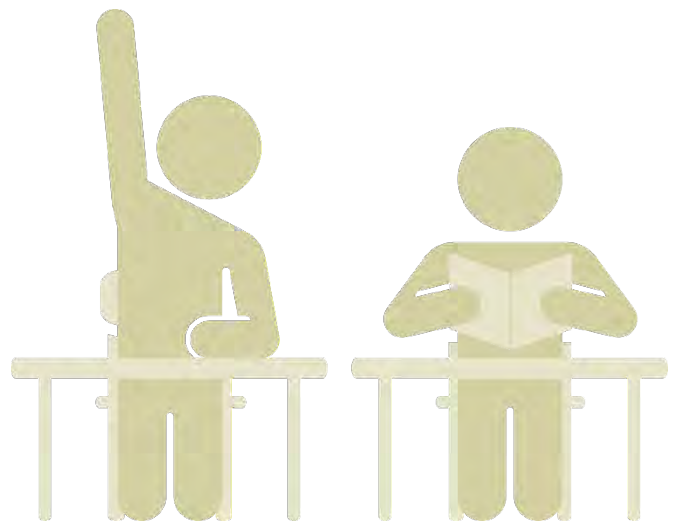
The percentage proficient in ELA increased from 22.6% in 2023-2024 to 26.7% in 2024-2025. The percentage proficient in Math increased from 10% in 23-24 to 12.7% in 2024-25. Discipline occurrences decreased by 34% from 2024 to 2025.

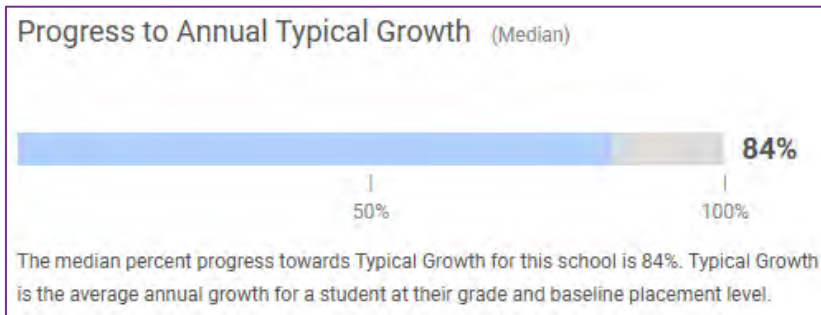




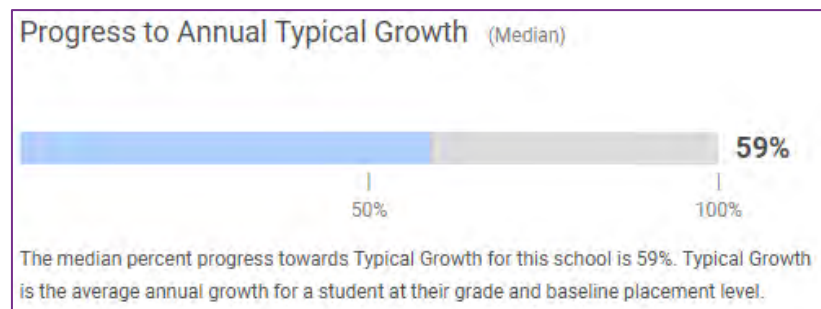

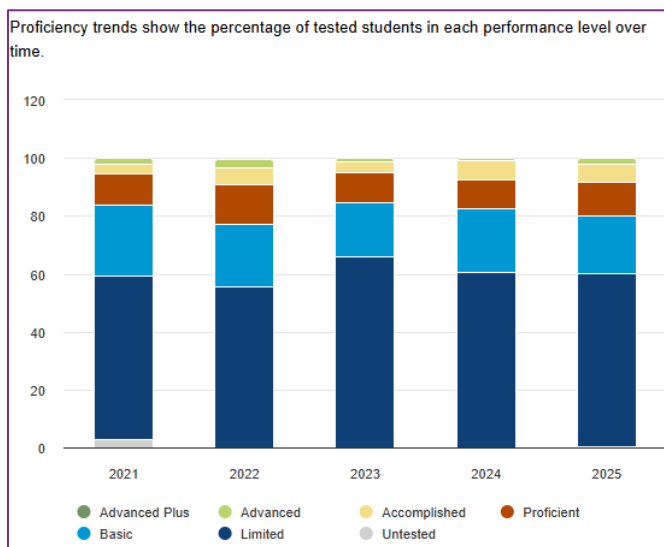
